Working Rite is rolling out six new projects throughout Scotland as part of an expansion of operations with Skills Development Scotland. This adds to our established projects in Glasgow, Borders, Perth and Dundee & Angus.

The first will be in Drumchapel, Working Rite's second project in Glasgow. Youngsters will embark on a "Targeted Pathways to Apprenticeship" project which will give them invaluable work experience with contractors from their local area. This project will start in June.

Soon after Drumchapel, the next project will be in Aberdeen, city and shire, working with Langstane Housing Association. Here, youngsters will also complete a "Targeted Pathways to Apprenticeship".

Later this year we hope to launch further projects in the Highlands and the central belt.
